Club Health 2011 will be held in Prague, Czech Republic - one of the world's leading interntional nightlife destinations. - All abstracts must be submitted using the online abstract form at www.clubhealthprague2011.com
- Abstracts should be a brief summary of your proposed presentation and should not exceed 250 words in length
- Abstracts must be submitted in English

All accepted abstracts will be published in the abstract book, which will be issued to delegates upon registration at the conference.

#### Deadlines

The deadline for abstract submission is **Friday 12 August 2011**. Notification of acceptance or rejection will be provided in September 2011.


